The city of Logan which is home to more than 400,000 people from more than 234 different cultures. It is nestled between Brisbane and the Gold Coast - only 35 minutes from Brisbane City and the Gold Coast.

It is a diverse location of rivers, urban hubs and open space, bringing together natural beauty, heart-pumping adventure, historical sites, culture and unique shopping experiences. There are pristine regional parks beside the Logan River, walking and cycling trails through wetlands and bushland. The city offers unique experiences from meditation in the Chinese Chung Tian Buddhist Temple, to the bustling Global Food Markets, each Sunday packed with produce from Asia, Africa and Europe.
