ONE COACH. REAL SUPPORT.

- Travelling together on one coach helps reduce the number of cars on the road.
- Group travel can remove around 10 to 15 cars from the route.
- Our coach has the fuel capacity to complete the journey if needed.
- Refuelling can be planned in larger centres to support responsible fuel use.

HOW IT WORKS

Created with care, this special journey gives guests the opportunity to travel meaningfully while supporting the communities we visit. Guests pay as they go for meals, attractions, shopping and personal purchases, while accommodation options and pricing are provided in advance and prepaid to Fun Over 50 Holidays for ease and peace of mind. Existing bookings on standard Fun Over 50 Holidays tours are non-transferable to this cause, however we warmly welcome additional guests who wish to take part.

LOCAL DISCOVERY TIME

Guests can enjoy each town at their own pace, with time to support local cafés, shops, attractions and small businesses. After booking, information on available experiences and pricing will be provided to help guests plan ahead, noting some tours may have limited numbers.

TRAVELLER COMMITMENT

This is a purpose-led recovery journey, not a low-cost transport-only option. Guests joining this special departure are expected to support local communities through local experiences, meals, shopping and personal spending throughout the route.

JOURNEY HIGHLIGHTS

- Overnight stays in Roma, Charleville, Toogunna Plains Farmstay, Thargomindah, Cunnamulla and St George help spread support across multiple outback communities.
- The journey also includes visits through Toowoomba, Chinchilla, Mitchell, Quilpie, Eromanga, Eulo, Bollon, Moonie and Dalby, helping extend the benefit across the route.
- Charleville includes a two-night stay, allowing more time to support local attractions, operators and small business.
- Toogunna Plains Farmstay includes overnight accommodation, meals, station tour and sunset sandhill tour as part of the journey.
- Quilpie and Eromanga are included as day visits, helping spread support further into the outback.
- St George offers additional local touring opportunities, including a winery tasting and cruise.

IMPORTANT TO KNOW

REGIONAL COORDINATION SUPPORT

This initiative is being led by Fun Over 50 Holidays, with Anita Clark Tourism Services providing regional coordination support. While Fun Over 50 Holidays already knows many of the operators, Anita is assisting with timely council communication and coordination in some areas along the route that are newer to Fun Over 50 Holidays.

PAYMENT STRUCTURE

Accommodation is paid to Fun Over 50 Holidays prior to departure. Most other attractions and spend are then paid direct by guests in the towns visited, helping money flow straight into local communities and operators.
