- Powered and unpowered campsites
- Fully equipped commercial kitchen with dining room
- Camp kitchen with barbecues, fridges, microwave & seating
- Air-conditioned hall ideal for large group gatherings or wet weather activities
- Abundant recreation facilities including mini golf, swimming pool, tennis, basketball & volleyball, canoes, zipline, climbing tower, observatory, low ropes course & more!
