

Lions Club of Capalaba donate a refrigerated cook trailer to Lismore City Lions Club

The Lions Club of Capalaba had a specially constructed cook trailer which had not been used to its full capacity since the Covid restrictions. The trailer was in excellent repair and fitted with a 1.5 m3 commercial grade refrigerator, and two barbecue plates. It was fully self-contained and operated off 240volt power, either from an external source, or a suitable portable generator.

The Club reluctantly advertised it for sale at a price of \$11,000, which was well below the replacement cost.

The advertisement prompted an enquiry from Lismore City Lions Club, who had lost their well - equipped caravan style cook trailers and were now operating using a converted 6x4 box trailer. Arrangements were made for them to inspect the trailer to see if it fulfilled their needs.

In the meantime, the Board of the Lions Club of Capalaba discussed the plight of Lismore due to

the severe effect of the floods, voted to donate the trailer to Lismore City Lions Club as gesture of support between Lions and to support a needy community. The offer was gratefully received.

Lismore City Lions Club representatives Bruce Sheaffe and Rod Johnston arrived to inspect the trailer and take it back to a new home.

The end of this Lions year is coming close to an end, and you want to get a start on your training modules for your upcoming roles on your Club's board.

As a reminder, (and also as I have had a few requests on how to log onto the MyLion — the Lions Learning Centre), here is the step by step instructions on how to log onto the Learning Centre so that you can get a head start on your training.

MyLion - Lions Learning Centre

You need to be registered in MyLCI first — usually your email address will be your "Lion Account ID" and then your Password will be what you have entered.

How to find the available course Content Library:

- Access your MyLion account by logging in
- Select the "MyLion" icon up the top left hand corner where the nine square boxes are shown
- Select the "learn" icon (the 5th icon, it will be an icon that is an open book with an arrow on it)
- Select: Lions Learning Centre "GO" button
- Select "Content Library" on the left hand side and a list of all courses & learning paths will come up.

- Select the one that you would like to complete, and follow the prompts.
- You can pause the course anytime, and come back to complete it the course will be in the "In Progress" tab up the top of your Home Page screen, just click on it and then click the "continue this course button"
- When the course is done, it will be in the "Completed" tab up the top of the Home Page, and you are ready to do the next one.

Case Study

The TINO music section was started in conjunction with Music Therapist Dr Carmen Cheong-Clinch as part of Tune Your Mood - an initiative to promote young people's understanding of how music can affect their wellbeing, both positively and negatively.

Dr Cheong-Clinch uses the TINO website to explore related topics and promote help-seeking with young people who are inpatients at a number of QLD hospitals. They then create music playlists which positively help them manage their situation and consider their intentional music listening.



This project has grown so much it now has its own section on TINO featuring a number of playlists as well as music submitted by other young people visiting TINO.




