

The final Cabinet meeting for this Lions year was conducted over two sites - Logan Village Lions for the Saturday business where we stayed on to enjoy some fun with a lovely meal and some karaoke catered by the Logan Village Lions and Sunday's business was hosted by the Lions Club of Tamborine Village in the local hall, with a lovely home made morning tea. My thanks go to Lion Euan and Lion Paul for facilitating the Meeting.



IMPORTANT:

As the year is reaching the end, you need to ensure that your membership and service reporting is all **UPDATED**. Your invoices from District/Multiple and International will be issued in early July. Your invoices will be based on the membership you have as of the 30th June. The membership dues will be increasing in line with CPI on 1 July 2023. The annual CPI increase (All Groups Australia) to 31 December 2022 was 7.8%. Accordingly, MD member dues will increase by \$3.70 to \$51.10 (incl GST) per member per annum (\$25.55 per half year). District dues remain as they were.

LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL (LCI) DUES – As part of the staged increase in LCI dues posted at the LCI Convention held in Montreal, there will be an increase in LCI dues of US\$2.00 from 1 July 2023. Accordingly LCI Dues will increase to US\$ 46.00 per member per annum (US\$ 23.00 per half year).

Club Treasurers will need to account for these changes when developing their Club Budgets for next year and adjust their member dues as required.

I have requested 2nd VDGE Stuart to create another page for the Q1 web site to be a showcase for Lions in our District to highlight their businesses. This will give Lions members an opportunity to seek quotations for the services/goods they supply. This page will not be an endorsement from District but will provide an opportunity for you to deal with suppliers who are a part of the Lions family. If you are interested in your business being a part of this initiative please see information further in the newsletter.

The **NEW LCI** website is under construction and will become available later this year. In a few months, we'll be combining MyLion, MyLCI and Insights, along with some additional tools and functionality, into a unified mobile-friendly experience called the Lion Portal. Please help ensure a smooth transition. Make sure your Lion Account information is correct in MyLCI and has a unique, unshared email address.



NATIONAL VOLUNTEERS WEEK

What Does TINO Deliver?

- Content on over 50 health and wellbeing related topics aimed at 14-25 year olds.
- A simple and easy website to navigate from a mobile, tablet or desktop computer.
- Content from across Australia delivered in one central location (we've done the searching for you!)
- Information in a range of mediums; videos, factsheets, stories & even music!
- Options for young people to leave their own stories or music playlist.
- Dedicated area for indigenous created content
- A teachers and youth educators section with worksheets full of activities across a range of topic areas.

Case Study

The TINO music section was started in conjunction with Music Therapist Dr Carmen Cheong-Clinch as part of Tune Your Mood - an initiative to promote young people's understanding of how music can affect their wellbeing, both positively and negatively.

Dr Cheong-Clinch uses the TINO website to explore related topics and promote help-seeking with young people who are inpatients at a number of QLD hospitals. They then create music playlists which positively help them manage their situation and consider their intentional music listening.



This project has grown so much it now has its own section on TINO featuring a number of playlists as well as music submitted by other young people visiting TINO.

Be sure to check out this innovative way of bringing information and coping tools to young people.






