ROBINA LIONS CLUB

BIG RED KIDNEY BUS

In 2016 Robina Lions Club members went to the Multiple District Convention at Echuca Victoria. Whilst there they saw the Victorian Big Red Kidney Bus. All the Lions thought this was a wonderful project as one Lion had a family member with kidney disease and they knew how difficult life was when they had to have dialysis treatment 3-4 times a week for 5 hours at a time. Kidney Disease patients are confined to their local hospitals and their quality of life is constrained as they cannot visit family, friends or attend special occasions. Mental Health issues

are very common with patients as well. The Big Red Kidney Bus will allow patients to have some normality in their life by using the mobile dialysis service.

Robina Lions took a proposal back to their Club and asked if the Club would support a project to put the first Big Red Kidney Bus in Queensland. When approval was given the hard work began. A Memorandum of Understanding was written between Kidney Health Australia and Robina Lions

Club. The project was then taken to our District Convention for Robina Lions Club to undertake this project with District's approval.

We applied to Lions Clubs International for a grant for A\$103,000.00 which was approved. We began to fundraise for the Big Red Kidney Bus. We held a major raffle, trivia nights, high teas, Melbourne Cup Functions, Theatre Nights, donation tins at all BBQ's.

We raised \$300,000 by grants, fundraising and donations. Our next obstacle was for Kidney Health Australia to find a clinical partner.

Fortunately, Qld Health came on board with a \$1.6 million grant to GC University Hospital and finally the Big Red Kidney Bus was able to be refurbished, painted, fitted with dialysis chairs.

On 21st June 2023 the Big Red Kidney Bus was finally launched after 5 years. It is anticipated the first patients will be able to use the Bus in August, 2023. At this stage the Bus will be stationed around the Gold Coast to ensure any teething problems are ironed out.

The Bus has the Lions Logo on each side of the bus and a Lions Clubs International Foundation Logo on the back of the bus. It has 3 dialysis chairs, air conditioning, 1 Pads, 3 TV's, a small kitchen, wheelchair lift and all the essential dialysis equipment is stored at the back of the bus and in storage containers under the bus. It will be staffed by 2 nurses.



We are very grateful for all the fundraising & help we have received from Lions Clubs in the District and know without their help this project would not have been possible. All Lions in our District should be very proud of this wonderful project and know that everything is possible if you persevere.

LIONS FOUNTAIN ROARS BACK TO LIFE AT LISMORE CITY HALL

In a psychological boost in Lismore's recovery from the February 2022 natural disaster, the ever-popular historic Lions Fountain at City Hall is once again operating and welcoming people into the heart of the city.

The Lions Fountain has been the backdrop for many memories for the people of Lismore since it was first installed, whether it be wedding photos or other occasions.

Unfortunately, the fountain was badly affected by mud and debris during the February disaster.

Council's repair crew has now reconditioned the motor which sat in flood waters and mud, as well as reconnected the isolation switch. The lights have also been replaced and the fountain's floor re-sealed and repainted. The fountain was presented to the City of Lismore to commemorate the formation of the first Australian Lions Club by William R. Tresise in Lismore in 1947. The fountain was refurbished and rededicated in 1997.

Council considered demolishing of the fountain in 2016 but after a public feedback, it was restored and public artwork was installed as a contemporary tribute and unveiled in 2017, to mark the 70th anniversary of the Australian Lions Club.

The artwork, which has also been restored after the February 2022 disaster, tells the inspiring story of the Lions, its history and good work the organization has done in our local community and nationally.

2021 marked the start of the organisation's Breeding Program when ALHD whelped its first litter of Labradoodles from a Brood named Winnie. Since then, the program has expanded to include not only Labradoodles but also Border Terriers in an attempt to keep the tradition of having dogs of different sizes for clients with varied preferences.




