I hope this message finds all LIONS in good health and spirits, having successfully navigated the last few weeks of turmoil created by Cyclone Alfred.

I know that many areas of the district have suffered, from what I have been able to find out mainly power loss with some members still not having had their power restored as I am writing this message. If I am wrong and there are members out there who have suffered other losses please let me know as soon as possible. This is the time when we see the absolute best come out of all LIONS and we see them all stand up and support both each other and the wider community.

I think that we have been extremely lucky to have avoided a far greater disaster. The spread of affected areas across the district has been unbelievable, from one edge of our district to the other and a potential to impact areas all the way to our western border.

We have asked all clubs to ensure that they keep in touch and keep receipts for any disaster related expenses, but at this time we have had nothing communicated or sent to us. As a result, the executive has decided not to request a formal emergency grant (\$US15,000) from LCIF at this time. If circumstances change, we have up to 30 days from the event to put in the request which will be done if the need arises. There are very strict conditions on the use of the grant money (which have changed) and it was felt that we would be returning most of it to LCIF unused if we requested it. Having said that the district has substantial funds in the emergency reserve if needed, please make sure that you send in the receipts ASAP.

It is very important that we continue to look after each other, so please make sure that you reach out and contact fellow lions to make sure that they are ok. Please make sure that if you need a bit of assistance at this time (or any time really) that you ask for help. Your fellow lions will always be there for you.

Stay safe and dry till we see you again!

As always, we invite all Lions Clubs and their members anywhere across Australia to join us in celebrating this important day through any means that you can. Visit






