## DG Jorge Salles

I think that we have been extremely lucky to have avoided a far greater disaster. The spread of affected areas across the district has been unbelievable, from one edge of our district to the other and a potential to impact areas all the way to our western border.

We have asked all clubs to ensure that they keep in touch and keep receipts for any disaster related expenses, but at this time we have had nothing communicated or sent to us. As a result, the executive has decided not to request a formal emergency grant (\$US15,000) from LCIF at this time. If circumstances change, we have up to 30 days from the event to put in the request which will be done if the need arises. There are very strict conditions on the use of the grant money (which have changed) and it was felt that we would be returning most of it to LCIF unused if we requested it. Having said that the district has substantial funds in the emergency reserve if needed, please make sure that you send in the receipts ASAP.

It is very important that we continue to look after each other, so please make sure that you reach out and contact fellow lions to make sure that they are ok. Please make sure that if you need a bit of assistance at this time (or any time really) that you ask for help. Your fellow lions will always be there for you.

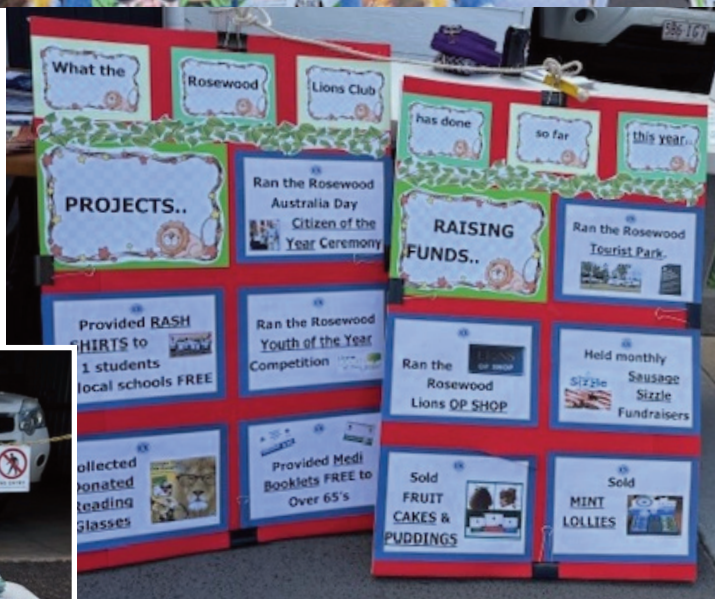

## Hands on Heart Australia

Monday 24th February our project was launched. We had 18 participants and have had very positive feedback already. We first came across an article in the Lions International Magazine in August 2024 when Hands On Heart Australia was launched through the Mildura Lions Club and thus began our journey.

Our **MISSION**, is dedicated to improving survival rates for individuals experiencing sudden cardiac arrest in our community.

We are committed to offering **FREE CPR TRAINING** to increase the number of people equipped to respond effectively in emergencies.

Our **GOAL** is to train an additional 300 individuals in our locality in basic CPR over the next two years, empowering our community with the skills and confidence to save lives. We will be focusing on year 6 children and youth as this is the generation that can make a difference.

### **PROCESS:**

**Pacific Coast First Aid is the Provider** of choice and will conduct the training.

The Provider will conduct face to face basic CPR and defibrillator training with no pre course work required. This course is a non accredited course.

We are seeking grants and sponsorship for this community event. **Locals helping locals to improve cardiac arrest and heart attack outcomes in our community.**

CPR awareness (including the performance of CPR) and the use of the Defibrillator have been identified as having a relatively low awareness in our community.

A person suffering cardiac arrest or heart attack in public (or at home) is heavily reliant on bystanders providing potentially lifesaving CPR.

Our very special guest at the launch was Graeme Tulloch from Mildura. His commitment to this project is evident by his presence here to launch Hands on Heart for our club. Graeme has firsthand experience of a cardiac arrest and the journey to recovery. He, in his wisdom, has turned his experience into one that can benefit the community by encouraging the education of CPR in Communities. This is what sparked our interest in continuing his cause. Graeme is a member of the Mildura Lions.

We are a service club and see this project is embodied within service.
